



BIOGRAPHICAL STATEMENT OF COURTNEY K. LEE

Courtney K. Lee originally joined Legal Aid Center of Southern Nevada as a consumer rights attorney in November 2006, when Legal Aid Center was known as Clark County Legal Services. Courtney left Legal Aid Center to spend more time with her young family. She returned to Legal Aid Center in February 2023 with a desire to make a community difference as the Directing Attorney of the Consumer Rights Project, after spending time in the private and government sectors.

In the interim connection of her Legal Aid Center employment, Courtney was in private practice in complex construction litigation and represented plaintiffs in construction defect claims against developers and subcontractors. Courtney also worked as General Counsel for a Nevada State regulatory board, represented the board in disciplinary matters against licensees in administrative hearings; drafted cease and desist, cite and fine letters to unlicensed persons/entities, or licensees who were in violation of statutes/regulations; drafted proposed regulations; and wrote newsletter articles about new statutes/regulations.

Courtney earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in political science/cognate in economics from the University of Michigan in 1995 with class honors. She also received her Juris Doctorate from the University of Maryland Francis King Carey School of Law in 1998, with a health law concentration. She served as the Articles Editor of the Journal of Health Care Law & Policy. As a proponent of education, Courtney returned to school and obtained her Master of Business Administration from the University of Nevada, Las Vegas in 2020.
