Advocacy & Justice Complex 801 E. Charleston Blvd



Advocacy & Justice Complex - \$7.5 million (Available for Sponsorship)



The most prominent recognition opportunity would be a monument placed in the front of the complex immediately left of where everyone will enter. Recognition will be developed collaboratively between the donor and Legal Aid Center and will list both the name of the supporter and an appropriate message on the monument pertaining to hope, justice, and/or why the donor is supporting the project.

Plaza Garden Breezeway - \$1.5 million (Available for Sponsorship)



Between the new Advocacy & Justice Complex and Legal Aid Center's existing headquarters is a garden breezeway. This prominent recognition opportunity would be a monument placed in a prominent location in the garden breezeway. The donor's name will be listed on the monument with an appropriate message pertaining to hope, justice, and/or why the donor is supporting the project.

First Floor Interview Room 2 - \$600,000 (Available for Sponsorship)



The Resiliency & Justice Center will have interview rooms where the interviewing space is more “soft” and comfortable as opposed to cold, sterile office space. This type of interviewing room is considered best practice for those facing trauma. The donor’s name will be listed outside the room indicating their support, and the donor can include an appropriate message on the wall inside the room pertaining to hope, justice, and/or why they are supporting the project.

First Floor Interview Room 3 - \$500,000 (Available for Sponsorship)



The Advocacy & Justice Complex will have interview rooms where staff can interview existing clients and new clients in a private setting to assist in providing navigation services and legal aid assistance. The donor's name will be listed outside the room indicating their support, and the donor can include an appropriate message on the wall inside the room pertaining to hope, justice, and/or why they are supporting the project.

First Floor Interview Room 4 - \$500,000 (Available for Sponsorship)



The Advocacy & Justice Complex will have interview rooms where staff can interview existing clients and new clients in a private setting to assist in providing navigation services and legal aid assistance. The donor's name will be listed outside the room indicating their support, and the donor can include an appropriate message on the wall inside the room pertaining to hope, justice, and/or why they are supporting the project.

First Floor Community Conference Room - \$350,000 (Available for Sponsorship)



Our first-floor community conference room will provide staff with space to meet with clients on their urgent legal needs and with each other as they collaborate on cases. The donor's name will be listed outside the room indicating their support, and the donor can include an appropriate message on the wall inside the room pertaining to hope, justice, and/or why they are supporting the project.

Second Floor Family Justice Project Main Entrance - \$1 million (Available for Sponsorship)



The Family Justice Project helps victims of crime such as survivors of domestic violence and human trafficking reclaim a life free from violence by providing critical legal assistance such as obtaining protective orders, divorce, custody, child support, and immigration relief. The donor's name will be listed on a prominent wall seen immediately upon exiting the elevators with an appropriate message pertaining to hope, justice and/or why the donor is supporting the project.

Second Floor Community Conference Room - \$600,000 (Available for Sponsorship)



The second-floor community conference room will provide our staff with space to meet to discuss cases, to meet with community organizations, and to receive trainings on best practices for helping survivors. The donor's name will be listed outside the room indicating their support, and the donor can include an appropriate message on the wall inside the room pertaining to hope, justice, and/or why they are supporting the project.

The Guardianship Advocacy Project prevents exploitation of our community's oldest members in the guardianship process. The project has been nationally recognized and promoted as a national model. The donor's name will be listed on a prominent wall seen immediately upon exiting the elevators with an appropriate message pertaining to hope, justice, and/or why the donor is supporting the project.

Third Floor Community Conference Room - \$500,000 (Available for Sponsorship)



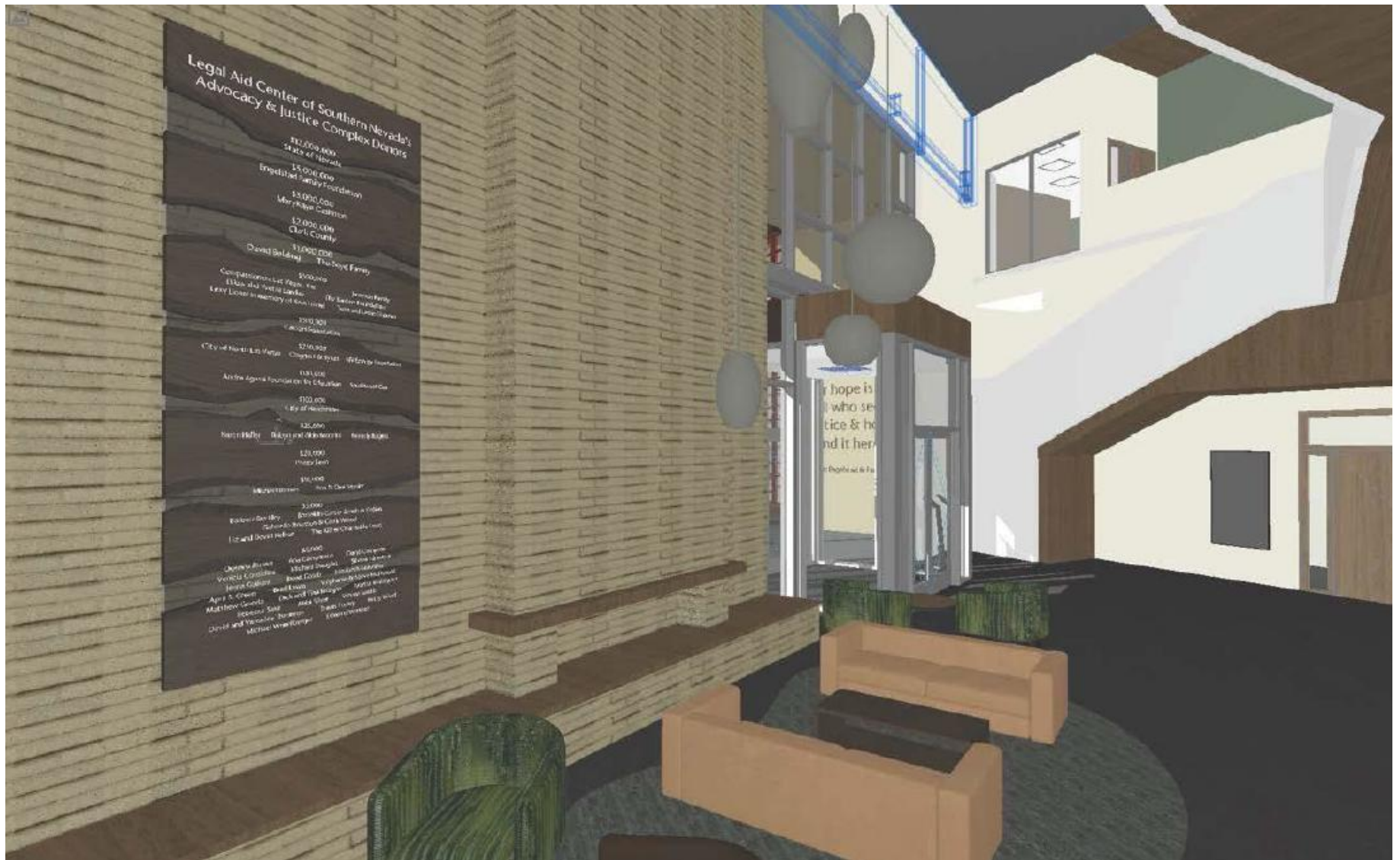
