



BIOGRAPHICAL STATEMENT OF DAMON DIAS

Damon grew up in Hawai'i and graduated from the University of Hawai'i. He later graduated from the University of Miami School of Law. While in law school, he volunteered as a counselor for violent youth offenders in the South Florida prison system and interned with the Dade County (FL) Public Defender's office. After graduating law school, he worked for a Miami law firm in their commercial litigation department before leaving to work for a Fortune 500 company.

After relocating to Las Vegas, Damon worked for the State Bar of Nevada where he led the lawyer referral service program before joining a local Las Vegas firm to practice in the areas of bankruptcy, consumer rights, estate planning, and domestic law. He later started his own firm where he added personal injury to his areas of practice. He closed his firm in the Spring of 2025 to join Legal Aid Center of Southern Nevada after years of volunteering with them as a pro bono attorney. He currently works with the Legal Service Fund in the Consumer Rights Project at Legal Aid Center.
