Emily then graduated from UNLV’s William S. Boyd School of Law. During law school, she worked for Legal Aid Center of Southern Nevada for the Education Advocacy Team and the Children’s Attorney Project. She also participated in the Thomas & Mack Legal Clinic in the Survivor’s Representation and Advocacy Clinic. In her time with the clinic, Emily represented clients seeking temporary protective orders and one client in a clemency petition. Emily is licensed to practice law in the state of Nevada.
