Genevieve Galman is the Assistant Director of the Pro Bono Project. Genevieve is passionate about promoting our mission of preserving access to justice and providing quality legal representation to those who cannot afford it. As Assistant Director, she coordinates case placements and handles cases from the Children's Attorney Project, Consumer Rights Project, Family Justice Project, Guardianship Advocacy Project, Immigration Advocacy Project, Resiliency and Justice Center, and Family Law and Civil Law Self-Help Centers.

Genevieve joined Legal Aid Center of Southern Nevada in 2023 as a full-time staff attorney for the Guardianship Advocacy Project. As a Guardianship Attorney, Genevieve represented vulnerable individuals with disabilities who were facing guardianship petitions. She successfully prevented unnecessary guardianships, enabling her clients to maintain the freedom to make decisions over their lives.

Before joining Legal Aid Center, Genevieve spent several years as a Deputy District Attorney for Contra Costa County. As a prosecutor, Genevieve was passionate about pursuing justice and advocating for victims of crime. She managed a large felony and misdemeanor caseload at all stages of the criminal justice process, including filing charges, arraignments, discovery, preliminary examinations, plea negotiations, motions, jury trials, and appeals.

Genevieve earned her Bachelor of Arts in Political Science and in Sociology from the University of California, Irvine and obtained her Juris Doctor from the University of San Francisco, School of Law. She currently serves on the Executive Board of the Asian Bar Association of Nevada and is the founder of the Filipino American Lawyers Association of Las Vegas.
