Genevieve Galman is an attorney at Legal Aid Center of Southern Nevada. Genevieve started at Legal Aid Center as a guardianship attorney, representing vulnerable adults with disabilities to advocate for their rights and wishes in guardianship proceedings. In 2023, Genevieve was promoted to Assistant Director of the Pro Bono Project. In this role, she works with the entire legal community in expanding access to justice by recruiting and training volunteer attorneys to take on pro bono cases involving child abuse and neglect, guardianship, divorce, child custody, domestic violence, immigration, consumer rights, appeals, and federal 1983 claims. Prior to joining Legal Aid Center of Southern Nevada, Genevieve served as Deputy District Attorney in Contra Costa County. As a prosecutor, Genevieve advocated for justice and public safety and managed a large caseload at all stages of the criminal justice process, including jury trials. Genevieve also currently serves as President of the Asian Bar Association of Nevada and the Filipino American Lawyers Association of Nevada.
