

BIOGRAPHICAL STATEMENT OF HALEY BOX

Haley Dawn Box came to Legal Aid Center of Southern Nevada to join the new Legal Service Fund team as a staff attorney. Prior to joining Legal Aid Center, Haley was the senior attorney for the Las Vegas Office of Nevada Legal Services, where she handled cases in housing (evictions and foreclosures), consumer law (collections, claims of exemption, bankruptcy, and auto fraud), and public benefits (Section 8 terminations, unemployment benefit appeals, and social security overpayments and terminations). Before becoming senior attorney, Haley assisted in building the Rural Consumer Law Project, which served 5 rural counties in Southern Nevada including rural Clark, Nye, Esmeralda, White Pine, and Lincoln, and provided legal assistance with housing and consumer cases to indigent residents of these areas. She also attended community meetings and forums, taught classes on consumer scams and housing rights, and facilitated Ask-A-Lawyer clinics on a weekly and monthly basis.

Prior to moving to Nevada, Haley worked for over four years in her native Alabama with Legal Services Alabama providing civil legal aid to the state's indigent citizens. In her years with Legal Services Alabama, Haley practiced in many different areas of law including housing, consumer, estate planning, public benefits, and family law for victims of domestic violence. Haley graduated from Birmingham-Southern College in Birmingham, Alabama with her BA in History before moving on to receive her J.D. from Charlotte School of Law in Charlotte, North Carolina.
