During law school, she was a student attorney in the Mediation Clinic, interned with the Public Defender’s Office - Juvenile Division, externed with two different Judges from the Clark County Eighth Judicial District Court, and had the opportunity of working with the Legal Aid Center as a Law Clerk in 2022. Jessica also served as President of the Students for Mental Health organization and was a member of the Public Interest Law Association and Dispute Resolution Society.
