

BIOGRAPHICAL STATEMENT OF JOYCE RILEY

Joyce Riley is an attorney in the Guardianship Advocacy Program within the Consumer Rights Project. She has had a long career in public service representing vulnerable persons. Before joining Legal Aid Center of Southern Nevada, Joyce was a Directing Attorney at Bet Tzedek Legal Services in Los Angeles where she supervised the Elder Justice team and the Low Income Taxpayer Clinic. Prior to that, as an attorney at Los Angeles County Counsel and later at Orange County Counsel, she represented the Public Administrator and Public Guardian in matters involving decedent estates, trusts, adult and minor guardianships, and mental health conservatorships. While at Orange County Counsel, she served as a member of the Orange County Elder Abuse Forensic Center team and represented Social Services Agency in juvenile dependency trials and appeals. Early in her career Joyce practiced as an estate and tax planning attorney with Olincy and Karpel in Los Angeles. Joyce received her bachelor's degree in business administration from USC, her juris doctor from UCLA, and her Master of Laws in Taxation from Golden Gate University. Joyce is a member of the California State Bar.
