Prior to joining Legal Aid Center, Marina practiced complex civil litigation and insurance recovery litigation at a law firm in Palo Alto, California. Marina is specially licensed to practice law in Nevada and licensed to practice law in California.

Marina received her J.D. cum laude from the University of Michigan Law School in 2017. During law school, Marina served as an advanced student attorney in the Unemployment Insurance Clinic, representing recently terminated workers in administrative and appellate proceedings, the Pediatric Advocacy Clinic, representing clients referred from the University of Michigan Health System, and the Federal Appellate Litigation Clinic, representing a petitioner for habeas corpus relief at the U.S. Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals. During law school, Marina served as president of the organization Law Students for Reproductive Justice and as a mentor in the Women’s Law Students Association. Marina graduated magna cum laude from Boston University with a B.A. in Political Science in 2014.
