

BIOGRAPHICAL STATEMENT OF PETER ALDOUS

Peter Aldous is a Staff Attorney for the Legal Aid Center of Southern Nevada Consumer Rights Project. He is the Bankruptcy Facilitator, assisting people who are representing themselves in Bankruptcy Court, and also assists clients with other consumer law matters. Peter has been practicing law in Nevada since 2009 and has extensive experience representing consumers in bankruptcy, fair debt collection, foreclosure mediation, and payday lending cases. He has guided clients through all phases of the bankruptcy process and helped hundreds of clients file Chapter 7 and Chapter 13 bankruptcy. While in private practice he regularly volunteered with the Legal Aid Center of Southern Nevada's Pro Bono Project.

Peter is a member of the National Association of Consumer Advocates, the National Association of Consumer Bankruptcy Attorneys, and the Southern Nevada Association of Bankruptcy Attorneys. Peter graduated cum laude from Thomas Jefferson School of Law. While in law school he assisted low income individuals through the Volunteer Tax Assistance Program.
