Wesley Su joined Legal Aid Center of Southern Nevada in 2020 as the inaugural Community Justice Fellow. The Community Justice Fellowship, sponsored by Paul Padda Law, is a one-year fellowship for new attorneys who want to work in a public interest law firm. As the Community Justice Fellow, Wesley will practice in all of Legal Aid Center's major project areas. Wesley began his fellowship as a staff attorney in the Consumer Rights Project and will also work in the Family Justice Project and the Children's Attorneys Project.

Prior to joining Legal Aid Center, Wesley graduated from the University of California, Berkeley with a Bachelor's Degree in Modern U.S. History. In 2019, Wesley received his Juris Doctor from the William S. Boyd School of Law where he graduated with highest pro bono honors. After law school, Wesley worked for a year-long term as judicial law clerk for the Honorable Linda Marie Bell of the Eighth Judicial District Court.
