

BIOGRAPHICAL STATEMENT OF YOLANDA D. MILLER

Yolanda joined Legal Aid Center of Southern Nevada in 2020 as an attorney with the Children's Attorneys Project. As a children's attorney, Yolanda represents abused and neglected children in foster care in Clark County.

Prior to joining the Legal Aid Center, Yolanda was an active duty Judge Advocate (attorney) in the United States Air Force. As a Judge Advocate and active duty service member, Yolanda served as a prosecutor and an appointed defense attorney at the trial and appellate levels. In addition to serving as prosecutor and defense attorney, Yolanda provided pro bono legal assistance to individuals with consumer, adoption, immigration, and family planning issues while also providing legal advice to high level military commanders concerning international law, ethics, environmental law, and labor/employment law. Over her almost ten-year military career, Yolanda received a number of awards as the top performer in her office including recognition as the best trial defense counsel in the entire Air Force.

Yolanda is licensed to practice law in the State of Nevada and has been an active member in good standing with the State Bar of Nevada since November 2009. She earned dual undergraduate degrees in Criminal Justice and Psychology from the University of Nevada, Las Vegas as a Millennium/Honor's Scholar.
